## **Fort Eustis hosts job fair aimed at veterans, civilian employees, family members**

FORT EUSTIS, Va. – A job fair with more than 30 employers will be held March 31 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Fort Eustis Club.

A joint committee composed of the Forts Eustis and Monroe Employment Readiness Program and Army Career and Alumni Program, Fort Monroe Equal Employment Office, and the Virginia Employment Commission is sponsoring the fair that includes employers with job openings like NASA Langley, Norfolk Naval Shipyard, Canon of Virginia, U.S. Secret Service, the FBI, Logistics Systems Inc, Dominion Resources, Riverside Health Service, Northrop Grumman and more.

“Our goal is to provide employment opportunities for all to include active duty, retired, Reservist, National Guard, family members and civilian employees,” said Edgar J. Williams, a veteran employment representative with the VEC. “With a Virginia unemployment rate of 7 percent and a national unemployment rate of just below 10 percent, we want to provide our veterans and their family members with the means to find gainful employment.”

Job fair attendees should come dressed for success and have several copies of their updated resume. Minor children are asked not to attend. For more information about the career fair, please call 757-878-4955.

To enter Fort Eustis, those with Department of Defense IDs will need to proceed through Gate 1 off Fort Eustis Boulevard. Those without DOD IDs will need to visit the inspection area off to the right side of Gate 1 to obtain a visitor’s pass. A government-issued ID, such as a driver’s license, and valid vehicle registration and insurance are required to obtain the pass. All vehicles are subject to inspection.

[Joint Base Langley-Eustis](#) is the combination of the U.S. Army post Fort Eustis and Langley Air Force Base. Together, the joint base supports more than 9,000 military and civilian personnel. The [633rd Air Base Wing](#) is comprised of three groups that provide installation support to JBLE. The Wing provides mission-ready expeditionary Airmen to combatant commanders in support of joint and combined operations worldwide. The activation of the 633 ABW as the new host unit Jan. 7, 2010, was the first step toward the creation of JBLE.
